We have openings for a midwife on ground in Uganda anytime from April on through December (2012).

We ask for a minimum of 6 weeks as it allows for continuity of care. It is a long journey so we recommend taking the time to settle in.

Visiting midwives work with our Ugandan traditional midwives who are the day- to-day 'staff' at the clinic. The work is an exchange between western midwives and local midwives. Everyone learns!

If we do have American students, visiting midwives are responsible for acting as preceptors. The Uganda clinic is currently in the process of being certified as a NARM preceptor site, but it would be helpful if visiting midwives became NARM preceptors.

Daily your responsibilities: 'On call' midwife for laboring and post partum women, conducting prenatal visits both on and off site (we have a mobile program where our midwives go out into the rural villages twice a week to reach women who can't get to us), and working with our sustainability groups on projects like beading, sewing and gardening.

We have a lovely 12 acre compound with gardens and walking paths. We have solar power, composting toilets and comfortable on site housing for our visiting midwives. We have a cook who makes wonderful local food and translators on site.
